Thank you for your email of 9 June 2020 (Ares(2020)2979821), in which you are asking for the use of the EU organic logo in the schoolbook [REDACTED]

The use of the EU organic logo (the logo) in the labelling, presentation and advertising of products, which are placed on the EU market as organic, is regulated by Council Regulation (EC) No 834/2007¹. However, the use of the logo as described in your email is not specifically regulated by this Regulation, but is subject to general rules on consumer protection and on the use of registered trademarks.

The use of the logo for information or educational purposes related to the existence of the scheme or the logo itself is in principle possible, as long as its use is not misleading and the logo is reproduced in a correct manner and, where relevant, in accordance with the rules set out in the user manual. This manual can be found on the following webpage and includes downloadable high resolution print versions:
